Helpful Talking Points

Understanding Good Touch & Bad Touch

- Knowing that you get to decide who touches you and that you can say no
- Boundaries (your own personal rules you make that others should respect and you respect others' boundaries/rules)
- Consent (asking others if you can do something before you do it and stopping if they say so)

Consent

- · Is a clear "yes" not the just the absence of "no"
- Cannot be given if someone doesn't understand what you're asking them to do
- · Cannot be given if someone is under 16 years old
- Is not just one question asked once, but must be asked for each activity each time you do it (example: hugging and kissing are two separate activities so you should ask each time before doing so)

Sexual Abuse

- Includes taking and sharing sexual images without consent, any coerced or unwanted sexual acts, or showing private body parts in public
- If you have been abused, it is not your fault. Help is available and you can call 509-326-2255 if you have questions about your intimate partner relationship or if you think your partner may be abusive
- People like social workers, doctors, nurses, and caregivers are mandated reporters, which means they must let the authorities know if you are being hurt so that you can get help
